Retention of Undergraduate Students Fall 2007 to Spring 2008

Executive Summary

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of undergraduate students enrolled in the Fall 2007 term. Using the Banner system, students were classified as enrolled, withdrawn, or graduated for Winter 2007 and Spring 2008. Those classified as graduated received their degrees in Fall 2007 or Winter 2007. The tables that follow look at four different (but overlapping) cohorts of students: all undergraduates, new freshmen, new freshmen who were provisionall fracthritemband disreplate the additionary, and this introduction to be additionary.

Main Report

This report tracks the enrollment patterns of the 1,962 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2007 who were classified Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors, or Seniors. A benchmark of the 1,778 undergraduate students who enrolled in Fall 2006 is also provided, for comparison purposes. Students who entered in **Fustioner all 007extense all 0**

Retention percentages for the various cohorts for Fall 2007 to Spring 2008 are below, along with comparable numbers from 2006-07.

Of the 1,962 undergraduate students enrolled in Fall 2007:

- 111 (5.7%) graduated in November 2007 or February 2008
- 274 (14.0%) did not return for Spring 2008
- 1,577 (80.4%) reenrolled for Spring 2008

After adjusting for graduates, the undergraduate retention rate was 85.2%. Note that Spring 2008 undergraduate enrollment had 235 more students then did Spring 2007. See Section 1, page 3, for more details.

Of the 456 new freshmen enrolled in Fall 2007:

- 62 (13.6%) did not return for Spring 2008
- 394 (86.4%) reenrolled for Spring 2008

The retention rate for new freshmen was 86.4%. See Section 2, page 9 for more details.

Of the 48 new provisionally admitted students in Fall 2007:

- 11 (22.9%) did not return for Spring 2008
- 37 (77.1%) reenrolled for Spring 2008

The retention rate for new provisionally admitted students was 77.1%. See Section 3, page 14 for more details.

Of the 273 new transfer students in Fall 2007:

- 68 (24.9%) did not return for Spring 2008
- 205 (75.1%) reenrolled for Spring 2008

The retention rate for new transfers was 75.1%. See Section 4, page 19, for more details.

The four sections of this report (below) focus on the four cohorts listed above. Retention patterns for each cohort are displayed by gender, ethnicity, minority status, citizenship, test score ranges, classification, high school quartiles, residency (on- or off-campus and county), and college.

Please note that in the tables that follow, "Withdrawn" does not refer to students who have gone through an official withdrawal process with the University. It refers to students who have not graduated and who


